






- Felt true joy.




May 24th, 1738


Fill us with your love, O Lord, and we will sing for joy. Fill us with your love, O Lord, and we will sing for joy.

Impress them on your children. Talk about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up..




Tie them as symbols on your hands and bind them on your foreheads. Write them on the doorframes of your houses and on your gates.





1 Thessalonians 5: 13b-23






Do not quench the Spirit's fire; do not treat prophecies with contempt. Test everything. Hold on to the good. Avoid every kind of evil.
