You have made them a little lower than the angels and crowned them with glory and honor.




You made them rulers over the works of your hands;

LORD, our Lord, how majestic is your name in all the earth!





Genesis 1: 1-4

Genesis 1: 9-10



-God's creation in the time betweenoriginal creation and the Kingdom ofGlory


Phase three: Creatio Nova


-Fulfillment of God's ultimate promise, realized in the return of Christ and recreation of a new world.
