



Thou, my soul's glory, joy, and crown.


Fair are the meadows, fairer still the woodlands, Robed in the blooming garb of spring.

Who makes the woeful heart to sing.




Hannah, Samuel's mother, brings him to the Temple

The boy Samuel ministered before the LORD under Eli. In those days the word of the LORD was rare; there were not many visions.





Then Samuel said, "Speak, for your servant is listening."






I, the Lord of sea and sky


