In the image of God He created them, male and female He created them.






We are created in God's image. From birth, we are created

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
#### It is more blessed to give than to receive. — Acts 20: 35



God doesn't mean for us to keep His grace —his loving kindness to ourselves.


He expects us to pass it on.





## Matthew 25: 35-40 (NIV)





The King said: "whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers of mine, you did for me." (Matthew 25: 40)




